No entries will be allowed after the deadline.

Awards will be given for first and second place for the winning floats in each category, and a banner will be provided for each winning entry to carry in front of the float in the parade.

The number of entries will be limited to 100.

The annual Christmas parade is a community project, and we sincerely thank you in advance for your support!

Please be advised that no refunds will be issued.

Information and Rules

Line-up Points:

- Marching Groups St. Mark's Episcopal Church back parking lot, no later than 5:30 p.m. A drop off point is provided for vehicles entering St. Mark's lot from North Greenwood Street.
- Bands Small parking lot next to LaGrange High expansion building by 5:30 p.m.
- Floats Granger parking lot across from LaGrange High by 4:15 p.m.
- **Vehicles** Those that comply with the description below, in Granger parking lot across from LaGrange High School by 4:15 p.m.
- Vehicles (Trucks) No individuals may enter a truck or car in the parade. Trucks will <u>only</u> be allowed if they are <u>decorated</u> according to the parade theme and are carrying a group of people representing an organization. Trucks will not be allowed with only a business sign on them instead, business trucks are encouraged to pull a float.
- **Vehicles (Cars)** A convertible or an antique vehicle may be entered <u>only</u> if it is carrying a dignitary or winner of a pageant.
- Vehicles (Other) No ambulances or large vehicles (vans, RV's, etc. are allowed unless they are pulling a float.

When dropping off someone at the parade, do not drive through the line-up points at Granger Park. Everyone must disembark on Highland Avenue or at the Granger Track; no drop-offs will be allowed on North Greenwood Street and no traffic will be allowed on Granger Drive except floats. There will be no parking on either side of North Greenwood in front of the school nor on Hunnicutt Place between North Greenwood and Granger Drive. Emory Clark-Holder Clinic parking lot usually has available parking spaces.

Anyone driving a float and/or motorized vehicle must have a valid driver's license.

Santa Claus is a special guest and we ask that no other Santa be included in the parade.

You will be contacted as to your entry number and line-up point. Be sure **everyone** in your group, on your float, in your vehicle, etc. has a **nametag** with the **entry number** before they arrive at the staging area.

Safety:

We require that all children's groups arrive as a group with an adult leader. Group leaders, please stay with your group after the parade until each child has been picked up by his/her parent/guardian. It is required that all parade participants wear a nametag, which includes your entry number.

During the parade, all entries should keep 20-feet from the entry they are following. Marching groups may not stop to perform along the parade route.

Any entry throwing or handing out any items along the parade route will be **removed** from the parade. This creates a safety hazard for small children as they may run into the parade traffic to retrieve items and flyers and brochures are left along the route as trash to be picked up.

Foghorns are prohibited, as they scare small children.

Route:

The parade will begin at Granger Park and head south on North Greenwood Street. Marching groups will be merged into the parade from St. Mark's. The procession will go down North Greenwood to Haralson Street, where the group will turn east. The group will turn right from Haralson onto Church Street and travel south through the square and down Bull Street, turning left onto Broome Street and making another left to head north up Main Street, again through the square, and up Ridley. All floats must be capable of making the left turn onto Broome St. Units longer than 45 feet can no longer be accommodated.

Marching groups may begin to drop out at Battle Street. Floats and motor-driven vehicles should continue north on Ridley to Highland Avenue, turn left and head to Granger Park before letting anyone off.

Awards:

All floats must be in place and ready to be judged by 4:15 p.m. Judging will begin promptly at 4:30 p.m. In order for an entry to be considered for an award, the application form must be submitted and the entry fee paid no later than 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 21. The same float cannot be entered year after year to be judged.

No entries will be allowed after the deadline.

Please send a representative to the steps of LaGrange High School at 5:30 p.m. for the announcement of winners and to pick up the banner and trophy. We will not be able to deliver awards to the winners except at the steps.

A parade representative will pick up the banner at the end of the parade route on Ridley Avenue.
