HILLS & DALES ESTATE

A must-see for architectural, horticultural or historical aficionados, Hills & Dales Estate is the Italian villa-style home of textile magnate Fuller Earle Callaway and his family. Designed by the noted Atlanta-based architectural firm Hentz & Reid, Hills & Dales was built on the site of the old Ferrell home and was completed in 1916. The home complements the formal boxwood gardens planted earlier in the mid-19th century by Sarah Ferrell.

LEGACY MUSEUM ON MAIN

Hundreds of artifacts depicting traditional life in LaGrange are on display at the Legacy Museum on Main, including a replica covered bridge built by renowned bridge builder Horace King, a slave whose skills and master craftsmanship earned him independence.

BELLEVUE

Built in 1855, Bellevue is the historic home of senator and statesman Benjamin Harvey Hill. It was named a national historic landmark in 1973 and remains a significant example of the “domesticated temple” form of Greek Revival-style architecture popular in the antebellum South. In 1861, The Nancy Harts militia, formed in LaGrange during the first weeks of the Civil War, held their first organizing meeting on the grounds of Bellevue.

LITTLE WHITE HOUSE
